A new era for VERT: Vertual Ltd. announces the release of VERT 4 heralding a new approach for their world-leading VERT "flight simulator for Linacs" software and the software support program.

VERT 4 represents a new approach for Vertual; customers have asked for more frequent software releases to help them train today's radiotherapy professionals. Vertual is focussed on meeting customer needs, and we have listened to their requests and plan to introduce annual releases of the VERT software starting with VERT 4 becoming available just one year after the VERT 3.3 release. About VERT 4

Imaging is a large component of radiotherapy treatment and techniques, and VERT 4 has advanced imaging capabilities, including PET and image matching enhancements. Dose-volume histograms are a new addition, a feature requested by many of our customers to explain treatment planning decisions and the value of different techniques. Dose menu changes and numerous usability improvements form part of the many improvements included within the VERT 4 software. Our development team have also created new patient models with a variety of orientations. Further information is available in the release notes.

The IBA Proteus ONE Proton model is now available as an upgrade for VERT, and further Proton software enhancements will be available soon.

Debra Leeves, CEO Vertual Ltd. says "It is my goal to continue developing and releasing a pipeline of new products that our customers want, and which meet the changing needs of radiation therapy and the way we teach healthcare professionals and students of the future. VERT 4 software has some amazing features, which I know will enhance the way radiation therapy is taught."

As we make final preparations for the VERT 4 rollout, we are already making plans for a Proton specific release in the coming months and looking forward to developing the VERT 5 software and beyond. Vertual recognises that different platforms are required for the VERT software, and we are planning developments to offer our customers enhanced flexibility and tools for teaching.
